

# Materials, Equipment, Features, and Services

Everything we have and do for you, inside the library or out.

## Materials

With your library card, you have access to books, DVDs, audio books, large print books, magazines, newspapers, E-books and music CDs. If we do not own it or have it on the shelf, we can place “a hold” on another library's copy, and borrow it in for you.

## Equipment

The Library has 3 internet-ready computers available for public use. Each computer can print to a color printer/copier which can also scan. We also have a fax machine and wireless (Wi-Fi) internet access.

## Copying/Printing

Copies and black & white printouts:

- \$.25 each for 1-8copies
- \$.10 each for 9 or more copies

Color copies and printouts:

- \$.50 each for 1 to 8 copies
- \$.25 each 9 or more copies

Each side counts as a page, so if the copy/printout is double-sided, the cost is doubled.

## CD & DVD Cleaning

\$.50 each disc (deep scratches may require more than one cleaning and may be charged double).

## **Fax sent and/or received**

- \$1.00 for first page
- \$.50 for each additional page

- Reserves for popular materials and items we do not own
- Downloadable audio books, magazines, and e-books
- Online catalog
- Two study rooms
- Homebound Program
